

Frequently Asked Questions

Does my ticket include the entire Museum?

Yes! Admission includes *Georgia O'Keeffe: Living Modern*, Reynolda House's collection on view throughout the historic house, and access to the gardens, trails and greenspace of Reynolda.

What time should I arrive for my timeslot, and how long do I have in the Museum?

Please arrive within 15 minutes of your ticket time. You are welcome to stay as long as you like until closing. We suggest allowing at least 90 minutes for the full experience.

What if I'm late for my timeslot?

We will welcome any visitor with a valid ticket unless the Museum and galleries are at capacity. In the case of gallery capacity, there may be a short wait before you can enter.

I want to give my ticket to a friend.

Can I do that?

Tickets are non-transferable. (Encourage your friend to buy a ticket and come with you!)

I reserved a ticket for Tuesday, but now I can't come that day. Can I move my ticket to another day?

Unfortunately, we are unable to switch ticket times or days. However, you may request a refund online for your ticket up to one day in advance of your scheduled visit and repurchase for a more convenient time.

Can I leave for lunch and come back to finish exploring the Museum?


Many delicious choices for food and drink are nearby in Reynolda Village, and visitors enjoy grabbing a light lunch or an afternoon treat during their visit to Reynolda. The Museum will accommodate re-entry when we are able, in keeping with our capacity restrictions. Please keep your receipt or eticket, and we will allow re-entry when possible.

I pre-purchased a ticket, why can't I get into the gallery now?

Many of the galleries in which *Georgia O'Keeffe: Living Modern* is installed are small, intimate spaces. To ensure an optimal visitor experience and to protect the art and other objects on view, we are limiting capacity in many of these spaces. This may sometimes lead to a small wait time to enter the Museum or a specific gallery.

What can I do before or after my visit to the Museum?

A visit to Reynolda includes the Museum, the formal gardens and trails of Reynolda Gardens, and a modern dining and shopping experience at Reynolda Village. Reynolda House is also just a short walk or drive away from Wake Forest University, recently named one of the nation's most beautiful campuses by *Travel + Leisure* magazine. Frequently Asked Questions

MEMBERS

How many free tickets can I reserve?

Members at the Dual/Family levels and above may reserve up to two (2) free tickets for any one day. Members at the Individual and Educator levels may reserve one (1) free ticket, as per the benefits of those membership levels. Members may purchase additional tickets for the same day. You will be asked to show your Membership card when you arrive.

MEMBERS

I am a member at the Patron (or above) level.

Can I use my guest passes to reserve extra complimentary tickets?

Unfortunately, we can't accept these passes for reserving tickets in advance. We encourage you to save those passes and use them for Centennial Christmas, beginning November 21.

WAKE FOREST UNIVERSITY FACULTY & STAFF

How many free tickets can I reserve?

Faculty and staff of Wake Forest University and Wake Forest Baptist Medical Center may reserve up to two free tickets (one for the employee and one guest) for any one day. University employees may purchase additional tickets for the same day. You will be asked to show your Wake Forest University identification card when you arrive.

STUDENTS

My admission is free, do I have to reserve my ticket?

Yes. Due to anticipated demand for this exhibition and to provide the best experience possible for visitors, we are asking all visitors to reserve their admission tickets online. When you visit the ticket page, you will see the option for a Student ticket, and you can show your student identification when you arrive.

STUDENTS

I'm studying the exhibition for class. Will I be able to sketch and take notes in the galleries?

In most cases, yes. Visitors are welcome to take notes and sketch in the galleries using pencils and small sketchbooks (no larger than 8 ½" x 11"). If you intend to sketch during your visit, we ask that you let our front desk team know upon arrival and please be respectful of other visitors in the galleries. Note that there may be some instances where sketching is not allowed due to capacity in a gallery, and our staff will notify you if this is the case.
